**FORM FOR APPLICATION FOR DISPENSATION**

**Note**

Under Section 81 of the Local Government Act 2000, a member who has a personal, prejudicial interest in any business of the Authority may not participate in the consideration of that matter by the Community Council, a committee, sub-committee or working group unless he/she has first obtained a dispensation from the Standards Committee. The Committee may grant dispensation to vote and/or speak as appropriate.

You may apply for a dispensation by completing this form and sending it to the Monitoring Officer not less than two weeks before the date when the matter is to be considered.
