CONSTITUENCY MATTERS

I have responded to residents request for information about council services and contacted council departments to initiate repairs to roads, street lighting and grounds maintenance.

There is a proposed housing development in the ward off Church Rd – I have attended a number of meetings with council officers, the developers and residents and raised many queries about the proposed development.

There is a significant road safety issue outside Castle Park Primary School and I have met with school, council officers and the police to try and address this situation.
