**RE: WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 SECTION 53 DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER TO RECORD ROUTES A-B-C-D; B-E-F & C-E AS PUBLIC RESTRICTED BYWAYS IN THE COMMUNITY OF TRELLECH UNITED AT PRICES BRIDGE, WHITELEY.**

On the 11<sup>th</sup> December 2013 Mrs Greatorex-Davies submitted under section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981(WCA) a Definitive Map Modification Order (DMMO) application seeking to add to the Definitive Map and Statement the routes as restricted byways. Subsequently, the Planning Inspectorate has directed Monmouthshire County Council to determine the application by the 13<sup>th</sup> November 2018.

The WCA 1981 section 56(1) defines public restricted byways as routes available to the public on foot, with horseback or leading a horse and with vehicles other than mechanically propelled vehicles.

The consultation plan attached shows the routes to be registered marked by solid black lines:-

- **A-B-C-D** commences from the County road C51-4, at point A, and proceeds in a southerly direction to junction with existing public footpaths 14 and 111 in the Community of Tintern and footpath 108 formerly in the Community of Trellech now known as footpath 122 in the Community of Tintern, at point D.
- **B-E-F** commences from the claimed route A-B-C-D, at point B, and proceeds in a westerly direction to junction with existing bridleway 20A in the Community of Tintern, at point F.
- **C-E** commences from the claimed route A-B-C-D, at point C, and proceeds in a westerly direction to junction with the claimed route B-E-F, at point E.

The routes are not registered on the Definitive Map and Statement. Mr Talbot of Moor Farm, Trellech has obstructed the routes bring into question the public status.

This has resulted in an application for a Definitive Map Modification Order that is supported by 46 evidence forms in which users believe that they have had the right to the use of the routes.

Before producing an evidential report to enable members to make any final recommendation this pre-order consultation is being conducted to investigate the routes as marked on the consultation plan by solid black lines. If you hold any evidence such as title deeds, photographs or other historical documents regarding the status of the routes and wish this evidence to be assessed and included in the evidential report please send this information to me before the 25<sup>th</sup> May 2018.

Furthermore, when considering the status of routes under section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, need, nuisance, security or suitability cannot be taken into account. These things are considered after the status is confirmed.

If I do not receive a response by the 25<sup>th</sup> May 2018 then I shall assume that you have no relevant evidence regarding the public status of the routes.






