4. <u>To confirm and sign the minutes of the previous meeting of the Monmouthshire Farm School Endowment Trust</u>

The minutes of the meeting of MFSET held on 21st January 2019 were confirmed and signed by Councillor Murphy.

5. MFSET Annual report for the year ended 31 March 2019
