

# Monmouth LAF meeting notes 18/02/24

## **NRW Update:**

## 1. Land Management update:

- We are still in a 'recovery' stage of the recent storms meaning we are prioritising clearing up from the storms rather than carrying out our day to day work programs. While the SE did not get as badly affected as other parts of Wales as people return to venturing further in to the woodlands we are finding further damage and trees down that we are dealing with ongoing.
- The Land Management Team will shortly be getting some CAM's training from the Local Authority to improve the response to issues and reduce confusion and double reporting for issues on PROW.
- Due to NRW's Case for Change we have lost two member of our team unfortunately.
- As a knock on to the heathland grazing project at Beacon Hill we have started to remove about 2 km of redundant fencing and gates on the site improving access especially for horse riders and those with physical impairments. We are aware that there as issues with mainly cyclists riding down the track and crossing the footpath at Red circle in the map attached.
- Wentwood steering group meeting: yet to happen however we are keen to engage
  with the wider landowners and key stakeholders to look at the future of the site in
  respect to recreation and access. We hope to approach the LAF for some formal
  advice once the stakeholder group has met.
- National Forest funding has been paused for 25-26 due to the case for change program.
