In that regard, with the Board we are overseeing the migration to Cloud Computing and facilitating the expansion of the SRS to provide IT services to other Local Authorities.

In addition I am jointly representing the Council on the Prosiect Gwyrdd Project and am a Governor at Shirenewton School holding the position of Chair of Finance. I am also Reserve Chair and Chair of Finance at Mounton House School where I am also a Governor.

I also serve on the Project board for the 21st Century Schools programme which is delivering new Secondary Schools to Caldicot and Monmouth currently .Two more are planned for Abergavenny and Chepstow.
