On the 4th May 2017 elections will be held to elect County and Community Councillors throughout Monmouthshire.

It is your chance to have your say in who you want to represent you at a local level. Whoever is successfully elected will play a key role in making decisions that effect your every day lives and influence the services your receive locally.

In order to vote you must be registered on the electoral roll. You can register online at www.gov.uk/registertovote or contact the elections office for an application form. Applications must be received by 13th April 2017.

If you are already registered you will be sent a poll card in late March 2017 telling you which polling station you should attend to cast your vote.

In order to stand for election nomination papers have to be submitted by 4pm on 4th April 2017.
